## SGA Report 12/4/2022

This report includes the number of academic hearings, the reason why they were brought to the Honor Board, and a broad description of the decision of each hearing.

In the Fall 2022 semester, three academic cases came to the Honor Board. Of these three cases, one was handled through an alternative resolution process and the other two through traditional hearings.

These cases were brought before the Board in response to *alleged*:

- Case #1:
  - Plagiarization of another student's answers on an exam
  - Discussion of the content on an exam (when such had been prohibited in the syllabus)
- Case #2:
  - Reveal of the form/content of an exam
  - Discussion of the contents of an exam (when such had been prohibited in the syllabus)
- Class #3:
  - Plagiarization on written assignments
  - Access to course materials during a closed-book exam
  - Academic integrity concerns

In response to each of the completed cases, the following resolutions were given\*:

- Follow through on pre-established decision to withdraw from the course
- Maintain regular contact with their Dean and other support networks on and off campus
