## The Chinatown Tutorial Program

The Chinatown Tutorial Program is a student-led tutoring program targeting K-12 students in Philadelphia's Chinatown. Working alongside tutors from Swarthmore College, Haverford College, and University of Pennsylvania, Bryn Mawr students develop long-term one-on-one relationships with students through basic homework help, teaching English as a Second Language, SAT preparation, and extracurricular activities. The Chinatown Tutorial Program also sponsors a special mentoring program each semester at the campus of a participating college, and these are often cited as the highlight of the program for both tutors and students.
